

1. Registration Form
2. Full Payment of Registration Fees - Due July 15, 2010
3. Uniform Jersey Deposit Cheque (postdated April 1, 2011)
4. Volunteer Cheque (postdated Nov 1, 2010).
5. New and Transferring Registrations should include:
 - 2 copies of Birth Certificate
 - 2 Proof Of Residence – copy of Utility Bill (Hydro, Cable or Gas)
6. Transferring Registrations require a Player Movement Application

LGIHA Registration Policy and Procedures 2010/2011

Registration – Late or incomplete registration could result in your child being placed on a waiting list until space becomes available. A player **WILL NOT** be allowed on the ice in September until their player's registration is complete and includes the following: Incomplete registrations missing any of the above will be returned to you. Any player may be refused registration to the association for indebtedness to LGIHA (e.g. Non-payment for specific fees; non-return of a uniform or other equipment, failing to volunteer, etc.)

Jersey Deposits are required for every player prior to your 1st ice time. Team managers **WILL NOT** be collecting Jersey deposits. Your post dated cheque's will be held by the equipment manager and returned or shredded upon the return of your Jersey's at the end of the season.

Cheques will be cashed for all Non-returned Jersey's.

Volunteer Cheque Policy

Langley Girls is 100% governed & operated by volunteers. It begins at the Executive level & works through the organization to Coaches, Assistant Coaches, Managers, Safety Officers and the parents. The Association in the 2007/2008 Season instituted a "Volunteer Cheque policy" of \$100.00 per player. It was based on the premise that if you did not fulfill your volunteer commitment your cheque would be cashed in lieu of your time. The Association Fundraisers help offset the costs for the Association, without these Fundraisers our registration costs would be much higher. In order to keep the Langley Girls Hockey Association running in a smooth manner and keep our costs down, each family is expected to volunteer approximately 10 hours per girl for Association Events. (This does not include time spent helping in the change rooms/ working the score clock or scorekeeping). This volunteer time will be communicated to you by your Team Manager. There are a number of different events you can choose from. Yes you can sign up for Events, Event volunteers will be scheduled on a first come first serve basis and any additional time required will be assigned to families by the volunteer coordinator. If the individual named for that assigned time does not show up or does not send an adult delegate from the same team your cheque will be cashed. Your cheque will not be cashed if you fulfill the volunteer requirements. We understand that some families do not want to volunteer in any capacity at all. In these cases the volunteer's cheques will be cashed at the beginning of the season.

The Association Board appreciates that not all parents hold specific volunteer positions in the Association, what we do ask is that you be willing and able to help out when called upon. There are a lot of parent volunteers working to promote Girls Hockey in an effort to ensure that all of our girls can continue to play hockey, build friendships and have fun. We all need to continue work together.
