



## Tournament Rules

Teams will be limited to a maximum of 19 players, which include 2 goaltenders and 17 skaters and a maximum of 4 coaching staff.

All CAHA, BCAHA and PCAHA rules apply.

Any player(s) and/or coaches assessed a Match Penalty, Gross Misconduct, or Game Misconduct for fighting will be suspended from further play in this tournament.

All ice time consists of 1-1/4 hours. Warm-ups will be limited to 5 minutes. The game should end with enough time to allow Player of the Game award presentations. If time does not permit, the presentation will be held in the team dressing room after the handshake.

All games will have 3 - 15 minute stop time periods. The third period will be determined on the time remaining of scheduled ice.

All minor penalties will be 2:00 minutes stopped time. All major penalties will be 5:00 minutes stopped time.

The Home Team listed on the schedule will wear the "light" jerseys, and the Visitor Team to wear the "dark" coloured jerseys.

After the round robin games are complete, all teams will be ranked from 1st to last. In the event that teams are tied, the following will apply:

The winner of the round robin game between the 2 teams will receive the higher placing. Similarly, if 3 teams are tied and one team has a 2-0 record in games against the tied teams, they will receive the higher placing.

If teams are still tied after (a), the team with the most wins will receive the higher placing.

If teams are still tied after (a) and (b), then the team with the fewest goals against will receive the higher placing.

If teams are still tied, the team with the best +/- rating will receive the higher placing.

If teams are still tied, the team that scored first in the first game played in the tournament will receive the higher placing.

In playoff games only, if tied at the end of 3 periods, there will be a 5 minute overtime, then a 5 person shoot out, followed by a 1 at a time shoot out until a winner is determined
